3. Complete and return all applicable request forms. (Forms also available on our website.)
4. Check one of the payment options listed on Page 4.

PJTC offers the following seating options:

General Seating - Unreserved seats in the Social Hall

Reserved Seating - Sanctuary seats are available for full dues paying members only for an additional fee on a first-come, first-served basis (except for 2nd day Rosh Hashanah - congregants will be seated in the Sanctuary only).

Life Seats - Individually assigned seating in the reserved seat section. Contact the office for more information.

Handicapped Parking - The PJTC lot will be used only for State issued Disabled Person Placard or Plates.

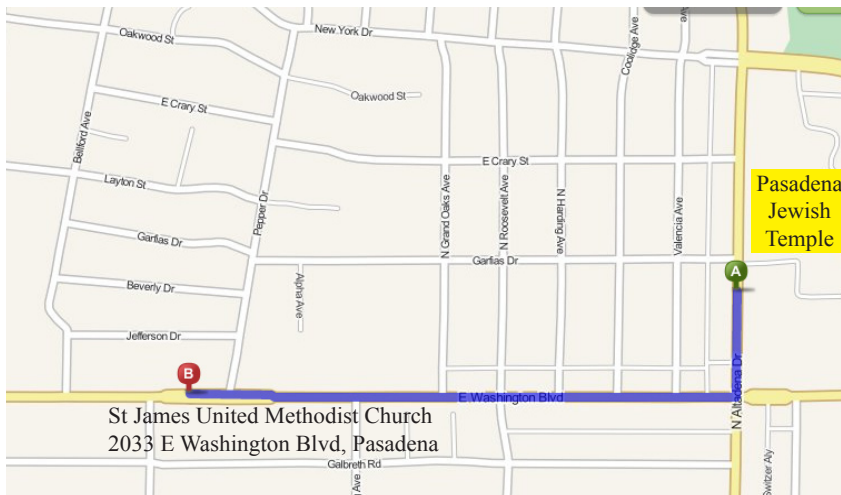
Parking Reservation

Parking on the PJTC campus during the High Holy Days is limited to members who are Handicapped or are Shomrei Zahav (Golden Guardian donors). These parking spaces are available by reservation only, and will be provided on a first-come first-served basis, one per family.

If all PJTC campus parking spaces are full, members are welcome to **drive in and drop off** those needing easy access to the synagogue and/or utilize the offsite parking and shuttle service described below.

In our effort to make the High Holy Days a full family experience, we have created a varied, multi-experiential program for your children of all ages - 18 months to 18 years.

Your children will have the opportunity to experience parts of the community worship service as well as interactive, meaningful and creative activities designed for each grade level and led by our talented Religious School teachers.

Child Care (2-5 years old, potty trained)

- High Holy Days taught through art, story, music, and movement
- *May be cancelled if not enough children are pre-registered (Min. of 5).

Kindershule (K-2nd graders)

- Kindershule a (mostly) student-led tefillah experience, as well as an exploration of the Holy Days through art, story, music and movement

Jr Congregation (3rd - 7th graders)

- Jr Congregation will include a (mostly) student-led tefillah experience, and electives. Electives will engage with the themes of the day through different modes. Register to request your electives.

Teens (8th - 12th graders)

- Post-Bnai Mitzvah students will ask questions, give mini-sermons, and laugh as they enjoy their own space during the Torah service on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mornings.

Pre-registration is required for all youth programs.

There is no fee to participate in the program, although donations are encouraged to off-set the costs.
